START/FINISH TIME: 9:00am to 12:00pm –finish by 3pm.

SANCTION NUMBER: 132033 - 2026

RATING: 5k & 10k rated 1B.

START LOCATION: Nevada Beach & Campground

416 Bitlers Rd, Zephyr Cove, NV 89448

DISTANCES/TRAIL: Enjoy nature with a relaxing walk thru woods and meadows. If doing
the 10k, join the bustle of casinos, shops and eateries in Stateline. Trail is asphalt, except for a
short distance on dirt, and mostly level with short, slight up hills. Strollers and wheelchairs may
stay on asphalt all the way. Paved sidewalks in town.

REGISTRATION: Fees: \$4.00 all walkers--**Park fee:** \$12 per car*

***Suggestion to save money** -- turn RIGHT on Elks Point Rd then LEFT into Round Hill
Shopping Center to meet your friends and carpool to the beach. **OR** you can walk to the beach
by walking down the left side of Elks Point Rd. and picking up a feeder trail just past Dorla Ct.
Stay straight, not making any turns until you reach the white striped crosswalk. Look for the start
table. You'll get 1 extra **K** added to your distance book.

MISCELLANEOUS: Restrooms and water at start & along route. Recommend 5k for strollers
& wheelchairs. Dogs ok on leash with pickup but not on the beach. (Dogs are allowed in boat-in
area and in campground.) Please wear a hat, use sunscreen and carry water.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS: 5k: 50 state-NV, USA-S, 10k: PAR, 50 state-CA, USA-S

DRIVING DIRECTIONS: From **I-80 Eastbound** exit #185/Hwy 89/Lake Tahoe for approx.
42 miles. Then turn LEFT onto Hwy 50. After passing the casinos, watch for Elks Point Rd.
(traffic light) and turn LEFT to the beach.

From **Hwy 50 Eastbound**, after passing the casinos watch for Elks Point Rd. (traffic light) and
turn LEFT to the beach.

Meeting Place & Directions Nugget Casino 507 N. Carson St (aka Hwy 395). Meet at the main entrance in the parking lot behind the building. From I-80 take Reno exit 395/580 then Carson Street exit about 2.5 miles to the Nugget. From Hwy 50 turn left onto 395/Carson St. then about 3.5 miles to the Nugget.

Trail Description: 5k and 10k are 1A. an easy, walk on sidewalks thru the historic district.

Miscellaneous: Restrooms available at start and along the route. Strollers rated medium wheelchairs hard.

Special Programs: 51 CAP, VETS, PAR, AML.

Cost: AVA credit and/or guest \$4.00

Are dogs allowed yes, on leash, but not allowed on Capitol grounds; must stay on the sidewalk. Poop pickup goes without saying.

August 9 -- Friendship Walk **Truckee Steiners' Memorial River Walk**

Start location: Raley's 10001

Soaring Way Truckee, CA 96161

Distance-Trail Ratings: 6k (3.7 miles), 10k (6.2 miles) – both rated 1B

Route description: The elevation is 6,000' and you'll be walking on an all-paved, undulating expanded river view trail. There is variable shade along the route with information signs pertaining to historic Truckee River. There are numerous viewing benches along the route if you want/need one and you'll have a chance to view 3 volcanoes. Who knew?

Miscellaneous:

Restrooms at registration and the beginning of the trail

Strollers would find this an easy route while wheelchairs would have difficulty

Dogs on leash with cleanup would be fine

Please bring and drink water along the route

Special Programs: Walk the USA A-Z, Par for the Course and Rails to Trails

Driving directions: From I-80, take Exit 188B for CA-89/267 S toward Sierraville/Lake Tahoe. Turn right onto CA-267 S for 1.4 miles. Turn Left onto Soaring Way. At traffic Circle, take the first exit and stay on Soaring Way. Exit the traffic circle onto Soaring Way. Turn Right into Raley's parking lot. Meet out in front at the picnic tables, near the left entrance to Raley's. After registering, there will be a short drive to the actual starting point (*see driving directions in walk instructions*).
